First stop on our journey, the Manapany basin, in the hollow of a jagged cliff.



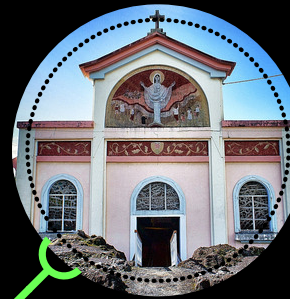
A desire for freshness? Your second stop at La cascade de Grand Galet will delight you.
